

The French 5,6 End of Course exam begins with a true/false listening section. Then, there are three grammar activities, primarily focused on *imparfait* vs. *passé composé* and identifying the appropriate tense base on context clues of a sentence. After that, there is a brief vocabulary section on travel and technology. Reading comprehension is next (two reading) and finally there is a “Grammar Application” activity that asks students to choose relative pronoun.
