possessive substantives: mio(s), tuyo(s), suyo(s) Nuestro(s)

affirmative tu commands, negative tu commands, affirmative and negative usted and ustedes commandes

no one, nothing, not one, someone, something

relative pronouns: lo que, que, cual, etc.

irregular preterites, and irregular past participles

irregular future stems

Verb tenses: INDICATIVE: present(include stem changing verbs, and those with irregular "yo" forms), preterite, imperfect, present perfect and past perfect with "haber"; future, conditional

"if" clauses with imperfect subjunctive with the other clause in conditional

SUBJUNCTIVE: present, and imperfect

Subjunctive: with nonexistent or indefinite things with expressions of desire or emotion or doubt after certain specific expressions such as ojalá, or esperar

direct (lo, la, los, las) and indirect object pronouns (le, les), and placement, including when they can be tacked on to the end of an infinitive

pronouns following prepositions (like conmigo, contigo)

por versus para

this and that: esta(s), este, estos; esa(s), ese, esos; aquel, aquellos, aquella, aquellas comparatives: más que, menos que, tan como, tanto como with verbs (Viajo tanto como tú.)
